

Mica Mosbacher, widow of the 28th U.S. Secretary of Commerce, is a political strategist and author of "Racing Forward: Faith, Love and Triumph Over Loss"; and "The Hurricane Factor: Stormside Voices". She has held national roles in five

presidential campaigns and is presently a member of the 2020 National Trump Advisory Board. She is a frequent guest on Fox News, Fox Business, BBC World News, BBC Radio, LBC, One America News, Hill TV, CBC Radio and other international news channels. Active for two decades in political fundraising, she has hosted or co-hosted numerous fundraisers for GOP candidates. She was an RNC National Finance Co-chair in 2012. In 2007, she served as Inaugural Chair for Governors Rick Perry and David Dewhurst. In 2008, Mica was appointed by Gov. Perry to the University of Houston System Board of Regents and served a six year term. She presently serves on the advisory board of the Women for Trump Coalition and on the advisory board of TPUSA. She has chaired many record-breaking charitable fundraisers. She served as Honorary Consul General of Iceland for 8 years and was named Dame-Knight Commander by the Royal Order of Francis 1.

Karyn served as a judge for the Stoa National Invitational Speech and Debate Tournament, a board member of the Coppell YMCA, a board member of Proven Way Ministries, a volunteer for Life Romania, and a teacher and leadership team member at Prestonwood Church of Plano. Brownlee received a Bachelor of Science in elementary education and a Master of Education in educational leadership from Texas Tech University.
