TFRW 33rd Biennial Convention Update

The Texas Federation of Republican Women (TFRW) held its 33rd Biennial Convention on October 13 - 16, 2021, in Round Rock, Texas, at the Kalahari Resort and Convention Center. CRW was represented by members Shelly Akerly, Karyn Brownlee, Melisa Denis, Sharon Kappers, Linda Mays, Angela Miller, Jane Anne Sellars, Kit Whitehill, Ann Dyer, Lynell Huffmaster, and Allie Hewett.

The delegates, alternates, and guest heard from state and national government and party officials. The opening presenter was Ronna McDaniel, RNC Chairwoman, who gave a challenge to each club to continue to show up, work hard and rally citizens to vote. She encouraged everyone to write their representatives and be the change that they want to see in their communities.



Melissa Conway, RNC State Director for Election Integrity, talked about how important election workers and poll workers are because they are the "boots on the ground" in the election process. Conway encouraged club members to step-up, voice-up, stand-up, and be plugged in through trainings. She said to "take a look back but don't get stuck there". Voter confidence is a priority; and election integrity is imperative in all elections so that each election will be "easy to vote and hard to cheat".

Other speakers included U.S. Congressman John Carter, Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton, Texas Senator Donna Campbell (SD25), Railroad Commissioner Christi Craddick, Former Texas Supreme Court Justice Eva Guzman, Governor Abbott's Advisor Steve Munisteri, Republican Party of Texas Vice Chair Cat Parks, Texas Land Commissioner George P. Bush, Lt. Governor Dan Patrick, U.S. Senator Ted Cruz, U.S. Senator John Cornyn, and Governor Greg Abbott.

At the TFRW Club Awards Luncheon on Friday, Governor Abbott and his wife, Cecilia, were the guests of honor. CRW received the TFRW Club Achievement Award and one of our student members, Rebecca Carroll, received the TFRW State Scholarship. Rebecca is currently a senior at the University of Arkansas.

Saturday included a Memorial Prayer Breakfast featuring The Honorable Glenn Hegar, Texas Comptroller, which honored those TFRW members lost during the past two years and a luncheon where the new 2022-2023 TFRW Officers were installed by U.S. Senator John Cornyn. CRW's Kit Whitehill was installed as the new president for the upcoming biennial.

CRW once again sponsored a patriotic jewelry sale to help raise funds for scholarships and campaigns.

The programs and speakers at the convention were empowering and promoted a sense of patriotism. It focused on how to rise above the banter and instead join in real honest conversations with conservative fundamental priorities in order to make productive change.
