Constitutional Amendment Election on November 2, 2021 Tools to be Informed

On Tuesday, November 2, there is an election on eight (8) propositions to amend the Texas State Constitution. Here are links to research the

constitutional amendments that are being voted on in the election next month.

1. [Visit the Texas Secretary of State website.](#) It will show the wording as it will appear on the ballot along with an explanatory statements for each of the amendments.
2. [Visit the North Texas Citizens Lobby website.](#) It will show the wording on the ballot, history of related admendments, and will address the three questions: Is it "constitutional"?, Is there a need?, and Affordability?
