Meet CRW's Honoree for the TFRW Tribute to Women *Sharon Kappers*

Sharon is a native Wisconsinite where she learned to love the Wisconsin Badgers and Green Bay Packers. She attended the University of Wisconsin in Whitewater before moving to Texas in 1984.

It was in Texas that Sharon became involved with the Republican Party. She attended the Dallas County GOP Reagan Day Dinner in 2013 where the keynote speaker was Wisconsin Governor Scott Wilson. This motivated her to become involved in political activities.



Sharon joined the newly formed Coppel Republican Women (CRW) shortly after the Reagan Day Dinner in 2013. After joining she became a precinct chair and has continuously served in that capacity.
